Ny-Ålesund:

- International centre for arctic environmental monitoring and research dependant on a near pristine environment
- Research stations from ten countries (Norway, Germany, Japan, Great Britain, The Netherlands, Italy, France, Korea, China and India)
- Ny-Ålesund is owned and run by Kings Bay AS.
 The Norwegian Government owns the company
- Kings Bay was founded in 1916 and was until 1963 a coal mining company

Please stay on the roads


The arctic tundra is extremely vulnerable.

The area around the settlement, is dedicated to science, and is unavailable to the public.

If you are going to the Amundsen Mast, please stay on the path.







Protect animals and plants

- All nesting birds in the settlement are subject to a protection order
- The Svalbard reindeer and the Arctic fox sometimes visit the settlement. Remember that they are wild animals, please **do not feed them!**
- The Arctic tern can attack if you get to close to the nest.
 Please do not hurt it!



Keep distance to scientific instruments

- Ny-Ålesund is a research station. Many of the scientific instruments are sensitive to human activities.
- Turn off your cell phone and the wireless network on your computer







Respect our cultural landmarks

All buildings and movable historical items on Svalbard from before 1946 are automatically protected

Ny-Ålesund is of great international importance as cultural monument. In the settlement 29 of the buildings are protected by law









Be aware of the polar bear danger!

Across the road from the shop the museum is located. A new exhibition was opened in 2016, and is well worth a visit. It is also possible to visit the old telegraph station.




